**SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION OF THE DUKANE MODELS  
DK100/DK120/DK130/DK140/DK100/90  
UNDERWATER ACOUSTIC BEACON**

Service Information Bulletin No. DK2009-1 replaces Service Information Bulletin DK2007-3.

Transportation of the Dukane beacons model DK100, DK120, DK130, DK140 and DK100/90 with a Battery Code of "B" when shipped by ground, are not subject to the requirements of the Department of Transportation (DOT) Subchapter C, Hazardous Materials Regulations if shipped in compliance with 49 CFR 173.185 and Special Provision 189.

Transportation of the Dukane beacons model DK100, DK120, DK130, DK140 and DK100/90 with a Battery Code "C", are not subject to the requirements of the Department of Transportation (DOT) Subchapter C, Hazardous Materials Regulations if shipped in compliance with 49 CFR 173.185 and Special Provision 188.

Transportation of the Dukane beacons model DK100, DK120, DK130, DK140 and DK100/90 with a Battery Code of "B", when shipped under ICAO, IATA, and the IMO must be shipped as fully regulated Class 9 dangerous goods.

Transportation of the Dukane beacons model DK100, DK120, DK130, DK140 and DK100/90 with a Battery Code "C", can be transported under the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the International Air Transport Association (IATA) in accordance with Packing Instructions (PI) 970 Part 1 (Lithium metal batteries contained in equipment).

Transportation of the Dukane models DK100, DK120, DK130, DK140 and DK100/90 with a Battery Code of "C" are regulated by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) under Special Provisions 188 and 230.
