SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION OF THE LITHIUM BATTERIES PART NUMBER
810-2007/K AND 810-2008/K

Service Information Bulletin No. DK2009-2 replaces Service Information Bulletin DK2006-6.

Transportation of the Dukane Battery Kit 810-2007/K when shipped by ground, is not subject to the requirements of the Department of Transportation (DOT) Subchapter C, Hazardous Materials Regulations if shipped in compliance with 49 CFR 173.185 and Special Provision 189.

Transportation of the Dukane Battery Kit 810-2008/K, are not subject to the requirements of the Department of Transportation (DOT) Subchapter C, Hazardous Materials Regulations if shipped in compliance with 49 CFR 173.185 and Special Provision 188.

Transportation of the Dukane 810-2007/K when shipped under ICAO, IATA, and the IMO must be shipped as fully regulated Class 9 dangerous goods.

Transportation of the Dukane part number 810-2008/K can be transported under the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the International Air Transport Association (IATA) in accordance with Packing Instructions (PI) 968 Part 1 (Lithium metal batteries).

Transportation of the Dukane part number 810-2008/K are regulated by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) under Special Provisions 188 and 230.
